

Indoor Worship FAQ

What will worship look like?

- Traditional service at 9:00 a.m. and Contemporary service at 11:00 a.m.
- Live music performances
- Corporate singing and prayer
- Small Talk for kids
- Children's Church (masks required for children and staff)
- Passing of the offering plates
- Communion on the first Sunday of the month



What can I do to help?

- Stay home if you or anyone in your household are currently ill or have been exposed to COVID in the past 14 days
- Be ready to give your name and phone # at check-in for contact tracing
- Maintain 6 feet distance from others
- Leave 3 empty chairs between family units
- Wait to be dismissed by row at the end of the service
- Catch up with church friends at a safe distance outside
- Volunteer to greet/usher or work the Tech Booth



What else can I expect?

- No registration required
- Masks required for everyone ages 2 & over
- Social distancing required for all
- Extra distance between the speakers/ musicians and the congregation
- Physically distanced seating
- Nursery care available by reservation only (masks for children age 2 & over and staff)
- Touchpoints (door handles, restrooms, etc.) wiped down between services



What should I bring?

- Face masks
- Your own beverages with lids
- Your own "Busy Bags" for your children
- Your own communion elements (on the first Sunday of each month)



Please be considerate of the safety of all others in attendance. We all have different levels of comfort with regathering. Our hope is that no one will leave our service feeling they have not been safe.
