

Outdoor Worship FAQ

What will worship look like?

- Full worship service
- Live music with corporate singing
- Small Talk for kids
- Children's Church (indoors, masks required)
- Nursery available with registration in advance (masks for children age 2 & older and staff)
- Offering box available outdoors
- Communion on the first Sunday of the month (bring your own elements)



What can I do to help?

- Stay home if you or anyone in your household are currently ill or have been exposed to COVID in the past 14 days
- Maintain 6 feet distance from others and wear your mask if not vaccinated
- Set up your lawn chairs at least 6 feet from the next person or group
- Catch up with church friends at a safe distance outside
- Exit around the building if possible or through the building if needed
- Volunteer to greet or help with set up/tear down



What else can I expect?

- No registration required
- Masks required when distance of 6 feet cannot be maintained
- Restrooms available indoors
- Dress comfortably for outdoors
- Worship will move indoors for poor weather



What should I bring?

- Face masks
- Lawn chairs
- Your own beverages
- Sunscreen, bug spray
- "Busy Bags" for your children
- Your own communion elements

Please be considerate of the safety of all others in attendance. We all have different levels of comfort with gathering. Our hope is that no one will leave our service feeling they have not been safe.
