



Thank you for your continued patience and cooperation as we continue to navigate health and safety concerns. Willow Hill will continue to follow guidance from the Centers for Disease Control, the state of Illinois, and the Illinois Great Rivers Conference as the guidance evolves. Here is what that means for practices at Willow Hill as of March 6, 2022.

- Masks are required in the church office.
- Masks are **required** in common areas of the building when Little Willows is in session, between 9 a.m. and 12:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Food and beverage may be served with the recommendation that individuals/families are at least 6 feet apart.

WORSHIP SERVICES

Indoor worship services will be held in the Worship Center at 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. and at Snyder Village at 10 a.m. on Sundays. Worship services will also continue to be posted online. We encourage people to engage in our meaningful worship experiences in person or through our website, YouTube or Facebook.

SMALL GROUP GATHERINGS

Small group gatherings may take place in-person or online as desired. Masking may be decided based on the comfort of group members. Meeting spaces must be reserved through the church office in advance of the meeting time.

CHILDREN AND YOUTH MINISTRIES

Children and youth ministries will meet in person following national, state, and local public health recommendations. Leaders will strive to maintain at least 3 feet of distance between participants at all times and at least 6 feet of distance when eating or drinking.

CHURCH OFFICE

The church office is open for business Monday through Thursday, 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. **Masks are required in the office when more than one person is present.** Staff will continue to work from home at other times with the option to work in the office as needed.

We will continue to monitor and support recommendations from public health officials as we move forward in our mission of *Gather~Grow~Go*. The Regathering Team will continue to meet as necessary, and modifications to our policy will be communicated in a timely manner. All persons are encouraged to follow recommendations of health care leaders and thoughtfully consider health risks when gathering with others.
